## What is it?

An amazing tonic that helps horses to feel well and look remarkably healthy. Scientific trials have shown that horses get better or improve condition quickly by boosting liver function.

***A properly functioning liver is essential for the health and well being of your horse and pony.***

Potential sources of liver damage include worming and worm infestation, antibiotic therapy, NSAIDs (e.g. bute), steroids, ingestion of heavy metals, pasture and forage toxicity from pesticides or mycotoxins.

## Symptoms of liver problems

Symptoms of liver issues include jaundice (yellowness of skin, the white of the eye and mucus membranes. General malaise, lack of sparkle, unthriftiness, lowered performance level, muscle wasting, dull coat, liquid diarrhoea, foul odour to droppings,

photosensitisation, mud fever and oedemas (including filled legs), head shaking, irritability, nervousness and changed mood are also indications of abnormal liver.

Another symptom of a malfunctioning liver is laminitis. Symptoms of laminitis such as inflammation in hooves are often due to the inability of the liver to cope with products of digestion i.e. from an influx of carbohydrates.

## What does Remount do for your horse?

Remount stimulates the liver to help regenerate damaged tissue and restore liver functions including bile secretions and metabolising enzyme production. The ingredients in Remount work together to prevent damage from drugs, chemicals and food toxins. This will improve metabolism and digestion. This leads to improved performance, movement and a bloom in health, seen by a sparkle, shiny coat and a bright eye. Your horse will be happier in himself, calmer and enjoying life more.

### Liver damage

Marinka de Haan, Netherlands

A year ago, Marinka's horse, Gwen became very unwell. She had lost a lot of weight, her coat quality was poor and she was unhappy.
